

20/20 Vision Check Look to Our God

**“Let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire.”
Hebrews 12:28b-29 ESV**

WORD: God, what are You saying to me through Your Word?

This year may be tough, but God has given us so much to be grateful for. What can we give Him in return? He wants us to look to Him and serve Him in a worshipful, well-pleasing way. Even the tiniest details of our lives are worship when we live for His glory through good times and tough times. *What is going on in your life today? Does it seem important? How does it become worship you can give to God?*

WHY: God, why does this Scripture matter?

God will reveal the truth of our lives: whether our worship is like gold, silver and precious stones or like wood, hay and straw (1 Corinthians 3:13-15). If our worship is like gold, then His fire will purify it and make it shine even brighter. If our worship is like straw, our selfishness will burn up and be worthless. *What is like gold, silver or precious stones in your life right now? What is in the “hay and straw” category?*

WHAT: God, what else does Your Word say to me about this?

The Gospel of Luke tells us about two travelers who encountered Jesus after His resurrection. They didn't realize it was Him until He prayed. As they later talked about what happened, they said, **“Weren't our hearts burning within us while he was talking with us on the road?”** (Luke 24:32). What they experienced in their hearts can happen in our hearts, too. Truly looking to God can light our hearts on fire with passion and desire for Him. *Have you experienced this? How do you feel your heart burning within you for God?*

WORSHIP: God, how do You want me to respond to this truth?

All that we do - every single thing! - is worship to God when we live our lives for Him. **His consuming fire will either burn up our worthless works or make our hearts glow with passion for Him.** With hearts afire for Him, we live for more than ourselves. We live for His glory and His Kingdom. Setting our eyes on this is a vision check that affects not only today but eternity. *How will you live looking to God for His glory today?*
